- spend a day in the **Roman spa in Baden**

Prices for 2015/2016 are:

Adults EUR 55, young people from 6 - 16 years EUR 25 and **children are free of admission** when accompanied by a Niederösterreich-CARD holder.

You can buy the card easily either online in the [online shop](#) or at one of the selling places. The list can be found on the [Niederösterreich-CARD page](#). The card is valid for 1 year lasting from 1st April till 31st March the following year.

So I think the offer of Niederösterreich-CARD is really awesome, especially if you want to explore the surroundings of Vienna or just are in the mood making an excursion.
